**1) ENTRIES:** CCIs \$755 US/\$985 CA, CIC \$445 US/\$590 CA includes stabling & taxes. All horses: \$50 CA/US muck deposit on separate cheque. REFUNDS: less 20% if received in writing by May 30 with vet /medical certificate. No refunds after May 30. \$50 CA/\$40US fee for horse substitution between June 1 to 3. Neg Coggins within 12 months. Cheques to Bromont Horse Trials. **ALL entries add \$45 CA/\$38US FEI drug fee and \$12 Canadian Eventing levy.** No refund if event cancelled. Electronic entries accepted at [www.evententries.com](http://www.evententries.com) (payment for online entries must be received by closing date to be accepted).

**2) TIME SCHEDULE:** June 6 horses may arrive 9-5pm. June 7, 12 pm competitor briefing & course walk; 3pm- 1<sup>st</sup> horse inspection. June 8 & 9 - dressage. June 10 – Cross Country. June 11 - horse inspection followed by Jumping.

**4) STABLING:** Extra days must be arranged in advance @ \$60 CA/\$50 US per day. Permanent & temporary stalls on grounds. Arrangements for non-competing horses must be made in advance. Limited tack stalls available @ \$375 CA/\$300 US. Shavings available for purchase. Please indicate date /approx. time of arrival on stabling form.

**5) DRESSAGE:** All Divisions: FEI 2015 Test B

**6) CROSS COUNTRY:** (Approx) CCI 3\* - 5,700 m@570 m/m, CCI 2\* - 4500m @ 550m/m. CCI 1\* - 3640 m@520 m/m.; CIC 2\* - 3500m@550 m/m

**7) AWARDS:** The Todd Sandler Challenge Perpetual Trophy awarded to the winner of the CCI 3\* division. The Eaman Perpetual Trophy awarded to the winner of the CCI2\* Division, the Law Family Trophy awarded to the winner of the CCI\* Division. Ribbons to 10<sup>th</sup> or per FEI regulations. Award to top YJ in CCI 1\* division.

**8) ACCOMMODATIONS:** See list of area hotels under "Visitor Information" at [www.bromontcci.com](http://www.bromontcci.com). Camping available on site. Water and electricity hook-up @ \$185 CA/\$175 US per stay– limited hookups - reservation required in advance.

**9) DIRECTIONS:** From Toronto – Hwy 401 east to Hwy 30E (toll bridge) to Hwy 10E. From Montreal, Hwy 10E. Exit 78, turn right. Right on Montreal St., left on Gaspé St. & follow signs for Bromont Olympic Park. From Sherbrooke, Hwy 10W exit 78. turn left – follow directions as above.

**10) OTHER INFORMATION:** All competitors must be authorized by their National Federation. FEI registration required for all competitors/horses. FEI passports required for foreign competitors/horses competing in CIC/CCI 2\* and CCI 1\* divisions, and for all competitors/horses competing in CCI 3\* division. CCI/CIC 2\*, CCI 1\* divisions -NEW 2017 FEI/Equestrian Canada passport requirements for Canadian owned horses. Cross country pinny holders required - limited number available for sale.
